True Easter Story, The (VT2836)

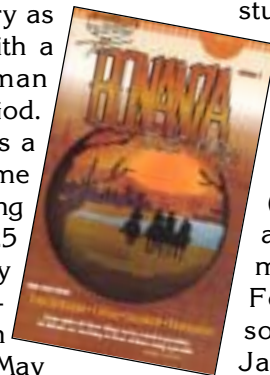

ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES FOR EARTH DAY

Man Who Planted Trees (VT2337): In a deserted area, a shepherd lives alone, caring for his sheep. With great care, he sows seeds and acorns, single-handedly planting and nurturing a forest of thousands of oak trees. Animation. 30 min. For ages 4-11.

Adventures Of Pepin And Dick Trashy (VT2435- 2438): Dick Trashy deals with littering, desecration, and vandalism, the environmental consequences of failing to recycle and conserve effectively. Land mark Media Production. 8 min. For ages 4-11.

Frog Pond (VT0891): People finally realize that their own comfort depends on the comfort of the frogs, so they hop to and clean up the pond. 20min. For ages 4-11.

Whose World Is It? (VT1002): Talks of attitudes toward nature. What can we do about the environment? Questions of Faith series. 25 min. For adults.

Universe Drama In Three Acts (VT1718): This is the story of Earth. Act 1–Beginnings of the universe. Act 2–The rise of the human race. Act 3–The need to reconcile ourselves with God’s universe. 15 min. For Jr. High & up.

Fruits Of The Forest, The (VT1699): Take a look at what’s happening to the rain forest, what mining and other interests are doing in terms of destruction and exploiting of land. An alternative vision for farming, and what people are trying to do for themselves are presented. 30 min. For Sr. High & up.

Greening Of Faith Series (VT2413-2414): Tape 1. Theology and Spirituality: This video explores the religious dimensions of caring for the earth. Tape 2. Ethics: This video is an introduction to the practice of a faith that embraces all of creation as neighbor. 30 min. For adults.

Warnings On The Wind (VT0570): This video talks of the effects of air toxins in the environment of the Great Lakes of Michigan and Canada. 30 min. For Sr. High & up.

Love The Earth And Be Healed Series (VT0699-0704): Six videos in the series. 1. Facing Our Dilemmas 2. In This Web Together 3. How Much Is Enough 4. Loving Nature 5. Not In Anybody’s Back Yard 6. Celebrating the Earth. 28 min./video. For Sr. High & up.

Keepers (VT2329): Keepers promotes an awareness of environmental conservation and the importance of the three R’s— Reducing, Reusing, and Recycling. 11 min. For Junior High & up.

Earth...The Changing Environment (VT1067): This video discusses the ecological consequences of improper economic development. 30 min. For adults.

Borrowed From Our Future (VT0903): The United Nations Development Program’s working around the world is telling how we are destroying the environment. 25 min. For Sr. High & up.

Global Brain (VT0893): Peter Russell explores the theory that the Earth is an integrated, self-regulating, living organism and asks what function humanity might have for this planetary being. 35 min. For adults.

Affluenza (VT1911): This video deals with the problem of over-consumption and its effects on society and the environment. 56 min. For Jr. High & up.

Relating To Your Environment: Ecology And The Bible (VT1566): This topic contrasts the biblical concepts of the inclusiveness of nature and “dominion” over the earth. Scripture Alive series. 30 min. For Sr. High & up.

Earth Summit: What Next? (VT1339): At the “Earth Summit,” held in Rio de Janeiro in 1992, Vice-President Al Gore remarked, “The ecological crisis is a spiritual crisis”; this video is a look at the role of the churches and the global community working together on a specific issue. 28 min. For Sr. High & up.

Common Good, The (VT2254): Some say the common good is that which benefits the majority of the population having justice or right relationship. This video focuses on the division of monetary gain and environmental loss. 58 min. For Sr. High & up.

For Our Children: Protecting Creation From Poison (VT0621): A contrast is shown between the people’s point of view that the environment is being abused and the company’s view of what is good business. How we resolve this abuse is up to us. 25 min. For adults.

How To Rescue The Earth Without Worshiping Nature (VT1238): Tony Campolo tells you why Christians should lead the battle to save the planet and how you and your church can get involved. 60 min. For Sr. High & up.

Stewardship Of The Environment (VT0653): This video looks at community involvement to rescue and to preserve the environment. It also explores the relationship between the poor and the location of hazardous waste. 25 min. For adults.
