

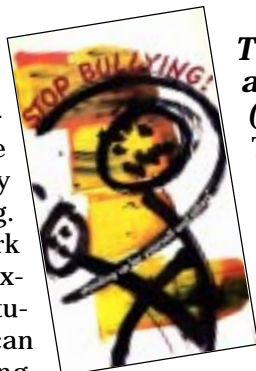


## NEW RESOURCES

***A Life God Rewards: Why Everything You do Today Matters Forever (VT3066-3067; DVD0027):*** Eternity. You may not have given it much thought. It seems so far away, so distant. In this 8-part series, Bruce Wilkinson shows why it's vital to serve God wholeheartedly now so you can enjoy the hereafter. (2 VHS; 1DVD; leader's guide, workbook, & promotional poster; 30 min./session; Global Vision Resources, ©2002; for adults)

***The Balancing Act: The Congregation as Emotional System (VT3069):*** Dr. Peter Steinke presents his revolutionary concept of the organic nature of congregations as people function and relate with one another. Using cellular biology and brain/mind research alongside Biblical theology, Dr. Steinke empowers viewers to take responsibility for their own functioning in relationships. The video is an excellent resource for leadership development. (1VHS; 90 min.; study guide; Seraphim Communications, ©1998; for adults)

***Stop Bullying: Standing Up for Yourself and Others (VT3045):*** Young people need to know what to do if they are bullied or witness bullying. Through presentations by Mark Brown, and students' real-life experiences, this video gives students concrete steps they can take to respond to bullying. (1VHS; 20 min.; Discussion questions & Support guide; Paraclete Press, ©2003; for Jr. & Sr. High)



***Bullying: What Every Adult Needs to Know (VT3046):*** Young people need guidance from the adults in their lives to deal with bullying in a healthy way. In this video, Mark Brown educates adults about what bullying is and what they can do help the young people when bullying is a problem. (1VHS; 30 min.; Discussion questions & Support guide; Paraclete Press, ©2003; for adults)

Crime mavens Awful Alvin, Greta Von Gruesome and Lampy join evil forces to steal a top-secret, over-easy egg raygun, with the plan of turning all of Bumblyburg into over-easy eggs. 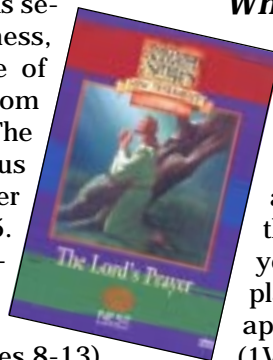
## RESOURCES ON THE BIBLE



***Bible, Fable, Fraud, Or Fact (VT2152-2153):*** Dr. James Kennedy is your host along with R.C. Sproul and Ravi Zacharias. Dr. Kennedy discusses how the Bible is not a product of one man but of 40 human authors and Dr. Nigel Cameron discusses how the Royalty Academy of Science, which is considered the foundation of modern science, was founded primarily by Christians. Almost every major branch of Science was founded by people who believed in the Bible. (2VHS; 30 min.; study guide; for adult)

***What's The Use Of The Bible? (VT0511):*** Among the speakers of this series are Bishop Tutu, Bernie Siegel, Ada Diaz and Daniel Berrigan. Questions asked are: What kind of authority does the Bible have for you? What role does the Bible play in your life? How do you approach reading the Bible? (1VHS; 26 min; study guide; for ages Sr. High & up)

***Answers With Ken Ham (VT2967-2978):*** Featuring Australian Bible teacher, Ken Ham, this series contains 12-part videos upholding the authority of the Bible from its very first verse. His presentation will equip Christians to defend the Christian faith and help you how to reconnect the Bible with the real world. This series discusses Biblical creationism. (12 VHS; 30 min.; No guide; Answers Media Production; For ages Jr. High & up)



## MORE RESOURCES ON THE BIBLE

**Dead Sea Scrolls: Fact Or Fiction (VT1564):** Host Kathleen LaCamera and Dr. David Otto examine the relationship between today's Christian beliefs and some of the Bible's oldest texts. (30 min.; EcuFilm; Questions guide; for Sr. High & up)

**Bible: A Literary Heritage—The Shaping Of The Western World (VT2202):** This film traces the literary and philosophical evolution of the Bible from its tribal origins to the ethical teachings of Jesus. The tremendous diversity of biblical writings is revealed. The film concludes with a sweeping presentation of the Bible's influence throughout the centuries on Western arts and humanities. (1VHS; 27 min.; Questions guide; Learning Corporation of America; for Sr. High & up)

**Time Travel Through The Bible (VT1195):** This is a two-part video program that transports the viewer to Biblical times via the archaeologist's shovel. Exciting new discoveries in Biblical archaeology are presented and add flesh-and-blood reality to Biblical characters. (1VHS; 107 min.; Leader's guide; International Lutheran Laymen's League; for Jr. High & up)

**A Firm Foundation: An Introduction to the Old Testament (VT1532)** In the four sections of this video, viewers will: learn what "canon" means and when the Old Testament was formally agreed upon; see the overall structure of the Old Testament and how it is similar to the Jewish Scriptures called the Tanakh; appreciate a new significance of the sacrificial system in the Old Testament. (1VHS; 22 min.; No guide; Interlink Video Productions; for Jr. High & up)

**Bible Teacher Kit (VT1765):** This kit is a teaching tool for teachers who want to have a Bible Study concerning Bible lands then and now. This video is in four segments—Northern Palestine, Southern Palestine, Places Paul Visited, and Life in Palestine. (1VHS; Includes 8 Bible maps, charts, timelines, glossary; video running: 53 min; Abingdon Press; for Jr. High & up)

**Discovering The Bible Part 1 & 2 (VT1445 & 1446):** This is a basic introduction to the Bible for those who have little or no background, but it is also a stimulating refresher for those who have long loved the Bible but never explored the story of where the Bible actually came from and how it was passed on to us. (2 VHS – 4 sessions; Includes companion overview, leader's guide, student worksheets, bulletin inserts; for Jr. High & up)

**How the Bible Came to Be (VT0310):** This carefully documented presentation shows the process of the Book of Books through the ages. Two volumes on one tape give a graphic overview of the Old and New Testaments and how they came to be written. Together, these two remarkable volumes answer many of the questions concerning the authenticity of Scriptures. (2 VHS; 55 min.; No guide; for Jr. & Sr. High)

**Ancient Secrets Of The Bible Series (VT1341-1353):** Shot on location in five countries, these programs will reinforce your group's faith using vivid dramatizations of Bible events, compelling debates between Bible scholars and skeptics, the latest updates about archaeological evidence, and solid, scientific proof for a belief in the Bible. (13 VHS; 22-42 min.; Discussion guide; for Jr. High & up)

**Old Testament Rewind (VT2886):** Ever wonder how in the world the Old Testament all fits together? This video gives a highly creative presentation (play) of God's loving and unending pursuit of His people from the beginning in Genesis through the restoration of Israel. Originally presented in Promiseland, the children's ministry of Willow Creek Community Church, this video has been used as a creative teaching tool for the adult congregation as well. (1VHS; 28 min.; Willow Creek Association; for ages 9 & up)

**Bible: The Great Adventure (VT2551):** This is the story of how we came to receive the English Bible, told especially for children ages 6 through 12. It's a fun-filled history lesson. You will join a wacky professor and his curious companions as they sing and dance their way through the world's most unusual archaeological expedition. (1VHS; 15 min.; No guide; American Bible Society; for ages 6 -12)



**Understanding the Bible (VT0963):** This video introduces to the development of Scripture in four segments. Segment 1 traces the development of the written Bible. Segment 2 discusses the formation of the Apocrypha and Old & New Testaments canons. Segment 3 explains that the goal of Bible translators has been to put the Bible in the language of the people. Segment 4 introduces Bible study using aids such as Bible dictionaries, atlases, concordances, and other resource books. (28 min.; Discussion Questions guide; Iowa Religious Media Services; For ages 9 & up)
