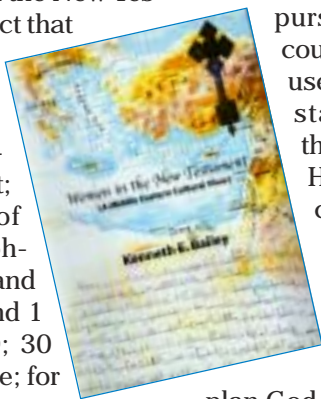

Women in the New Testament: A Middle Eastern Cultural View (DVD0321-0322): What does the Bible say about a woman's role in the church? In this six-lecture, two-DVD series, Dr. Kenneth E. Bailey deals with all of the important texts and finds a deep unity in the New Testament view of this subject that is often overlooked. The lectures are: 1. Women in the Old Testament; 2. Women Leaders in the New Testament; 3. Mary, the Mother of Jesus; 4. Women Prophets; 5. 1 Corinthians 14 and 1 Timothy 2; 6. Titus and 1 Corinthians 6. The Best Question Ever: Learning Foolproof Your Life (DVD0323): Can a simple question foolproof your life? For most of us, there are chapters in the past we would like to rewrite. Discovering God's Will (DVD0324): This resource is designed for small groups or personal study to take you through the important steps of decision making, pursuing God's will, seeking counsel from others, learning to use discernment, and understanding the mind of God through Scripture as you seek His will. The DVD includes 4 complete sermons and eight 12- to 15-minute group sessions that correspond with the study guide which includes a leader's guide, will help outline the amazing plan God has in mind for your life. Love Talk (DVD0325): Couples consistently name "improved communication" as the greatest need in their relationships. This resource by Drs. Jay Jay, The Jet Plane (30 stories; 10-12 min./ea.): Jay Jay and his friends learn biblical lessons.

Kingsley's Meadow (4 episodes; 30 min./ea.): In this animated video, kids will learn virtues and values.

Hanna Barbera's The Greatest Adventure Series (13 stories; 30 min.): This series is animated Bible stories from Creation to Jesus.

Human Race Club (6 lessons; 25 min./ea.): Based on the books by Joy Berry, this series is designed to teach skills for living and making choices.

Jacob's Ladder (13 episodes; 30 min./ea.): A group of young teenagers is transported to Bible times.

Jesus ... A Kingdom Without Frontiers (26 stories; 30 min./ea.): New Testament events from the annunciation of Jesus' birth to the Acts of the Apostles.
